John 15:1-10^{JCR}

¹ I am the true vine and my Father is the vinedresser.

² **Every branch in me that does not bear fruit He removes it, and every one that bears fruit He prunes it, in order that it may bear more fruit.**

³ Already you have been pruned by means of the word that has been spoken to you.

⁴ **Remain with me, I within you. Just as the branch is not able to bear fruit of itself, if it does not remain within the vine, neither can you, if you do not remain with me.**

⁵ I am the vine; you are the branches. He who remains with me bears much fruit, because without me you are not able to do anything.

⁶ **If one does not remain with me, he is cast out like branches and dries up and they are gathered together and thrown into the fire and burned.**

⁷ If you remain with me and my words remain within you, then if you ask whatever you wish, it shall be done for you.

⁸ **By this my Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit and be my disciples.**

⁹ Just as my Father has loved me, I have loved you. Remain within my love.

¹⁰ **If you keep my commandments, you will remain within my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain within His love.**
