¹¹ But Mary stood at the tomb, outside crying. Then, as she cried, she stooped in order to see into the tomb **¹² and observed two messengers in white sitting, one at the head and one at the feet, where the body of Jesus should have been.** **¹³** And they said to her, “Woman, why are you crying?” **She said to them, “They have removed my Master and I do not know where they have laid him!”** **¹⁴** As she was saying these things, she turned to behind her and observed Jesus, but did not realize that it was Jesus. **¹⁵ He said to her, “Woman, why are you crying? Whom do you seek?”** She, thinking that he was the gardener, said to him, “Sir, if you have carried him away, tell me where you have laid him; I will go.” **¹⁶ Jesus said to her, “Mary.” Turning abruptly, she said to him in Hebrew “Rabboni” (which says “Teacher”).** **¹⁷** Jesus said to her, “Do not handle me, for I have not yet ascended to the Father. But go to my brothers and say to them, I am ascended to my Father and your Father, and my God and your God.” **¹⁸ Mary Magdalene came, announcing to the disciples that “I have met the Master” and that he had said these things to her.** **²⁹** Jesus said..., “Have you believed, because you have encountered? **Blessed are the ones who have not literally seen yet believe!”**
