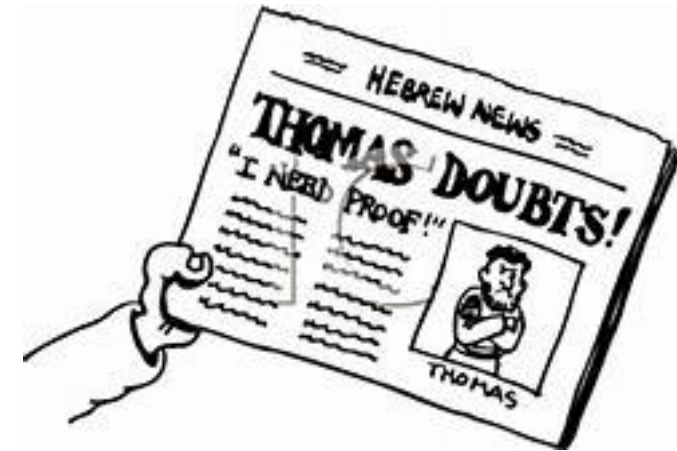

John 20^{JCR}

19 When it was later that day after the Sabbath and the doors were locked, where the disciples were, because of fear of the Jews, Jesus came and stood in the midst and said to them, “Peace to you!” **20 And having said this, he showed his hands and his side to them. Then, the disciples rejoiced, recognizing the Master.** **21** Then, Jesus said to them again, “Peace to you! Just as the Father has sent me out, I am sending you.” **22 And having said this, he breathed upon them and said to them, “Receive the Holy Spirit. 23 The sins of whomever you have forgiven shall be forgiven, of whomever you have retained shall be retained.”** **24** But Thomas, one of the twelve who was called Didumos, was not with them, when Jesus came. **25** Therefore, the other disciples said to him, “We have encountered the Master.” **So, he said to them, “If I do not literally see in his hands the marks of the nails and put my finger in the marks of the nails, and put my hand in his side, I shall not believe!”** **26** And after eight days, his disciples were again inside and Thomas with them. Jesus came through a locked door and stood in the midst of them and said, “Peace to you.” **27 Next, he said to Thomas, “Reach out your finger here and literally see my hands and reach out your hand and put it in my side and be not unbelieving but believing.”** **28** Thomas replied and said to him, “My Master and my God!” **29** Jesus said to him, “Have you believed, because you have encountered? **Blessed are the ones who have not literally seen yet believe!”**
