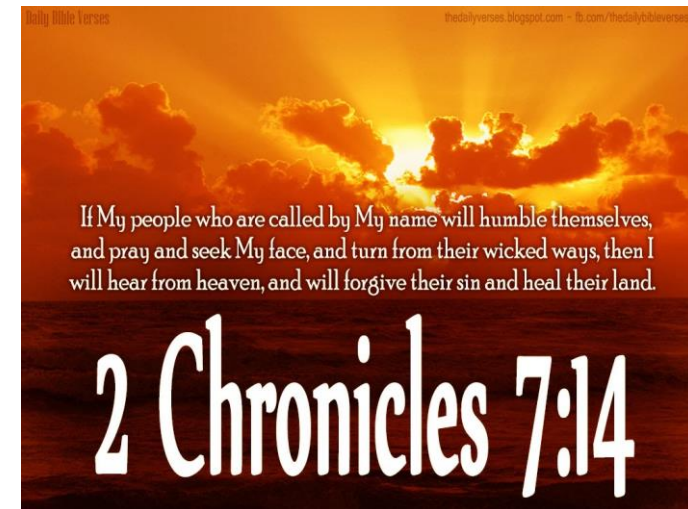

A Prayer for Revival

O Heavenly Father, we acknowledge that the pathway to the burning fire and refreshing springs of revival is faith. We remember that in the antebellum South, American slaves of African ancestry stole away in the darkness of night to celebrate salvation in Thy Name through Jesus.

O LORD, we, Thy people, are still in need of repentance and renewal. We seek the sacred hiding places in the hope of finding Thee.

Like Moses who approached Thee through a bush which burned but was not consumed, we desire to draw closer to Thee during this revival.

O God of Strength, may the power of Thy Presence enlighten our vision, empower our mission, direct our ministries, renew our spirit, transform our minds, heal our sufferings, and cleanse our souls.

When Joshua battled the Amorites, Thou caused the sun to stand still over Gibeon. Before David slew the Philistine giant and King Jehoshaphat defeated both the Moabites and the Ammonites, Thou did say, “The battle is not yours, but the LORD’s.”

O God of Victory, we confess that Thy strength is seen in our weakness, and that our best efforts are feeble attempts unless Thy Presence and eternal wisdom are with us.

Through the faith of a Hebrew maiden, the Israelites secured a leader—Moses; through faith Ruth clung to Naomi and Thou did redeem the future of all generations; even Rahab’s faith provided safety for two of Joshua’s spies.
